

Wood Elves Gloves

Cabled Gloves

Gauge: 30 sts & 38 rows in stockinette stich after blocking

Yarn suggested:

188 yards/172 m of Araucania Ranco Solid (or equivalent of fingering weight 75% wool 25% nylon) in 108 (main color).

Notions and needles:

5 DPN or 1 circular needle size 2.5 mm/US 1.5 cable needle

tapestry needle stitch markers

Size: 7-7.5 (S-M)

Note:

It is important to try the glove on a regular basis to ensure it is suitable for your size. This applies especially to the fingers (you may need to remove or add rows to the different fingers so that the glove fits your hand)

Abbreviations

K = knitP = purl

SLK = slip one as if to knit

PM = place marker

CO = cast-on

k2tog = knit 2 together

M1R = make one right (pick up the bar between two sts, bring the needle from the back to the front and knit this st in the front of the st)
M1L = make one left (pick up the bar between two sts, bring the needle from the front to the back and knit this st in the back of the st)

Pattern

Cuff:

CO 56 stitches using the German Twisted Cast-On

Place marker (M1) and join into the round, being careful not to twist the stitches. If you use a circular needle, using magic-loop method.

Row 1: *k3, p1*, repeat from * to * to the end of the row

Row 2: *k1, SLK, k1, p1* repeat from * to * to the end of the row

Work 1-2 six times

Work row 1 one more time (row 13)

Row 14: *k1, SLK, k1, p1* repeat 3 times, k1, SLK, PM (M2), work the chart, PM (M3), SLK, k1, p1, *k1, SLK, k1, p1* repeat 4 times

Row 15: *k3, p1* 3 times, k2, slm, work the chart, slm, k1, p1, *k3, p1* 4 times

Work 1-2 eleven more times

Continue in stockinette stitches for row 38-39 and work the chart between the markers M2-M3 (rows 25-26 of the chart)

Increased Rows

Left glove

Row 40 : k6, M1R before the 7th st, pm (M4), k1, M1L, k until M2, slM2, work the chart, slM3, k until the end of the row

Row 41 : k until M2, slM2, work the chart, slM3, k until the end of the row

Row 42: k until M4, M1R, slM4, k1, M1L, k until M2, slM2, work the chart, slM3, k until the end of the row

Row 43: k until M2, slM2, work the chart, slM3, k until the end of the row Work row 42 and 43 eight more times (76 sts)

Right Glove

Row 40: k until M2, sIM2, work the chart, sIM3, k8, M1R before the 9th st, pm (M4), k1, M1L, k until the end of the row

Row 41: k until M2, slM2, work the chart, slM3, k until the end of the row

Rg 42 : k until M2, sIM2, work the chart, sIM3, k until M4, M1R, sIM4, k1, M1L, k until the end of the row

Row 43: k until M2, sIM2, work the chart, sIM3, k until the end of the row

To form the thumb

Left Glove

Row 58: k7, place next 20 stitches on scrap yarn, join into the round and k until the end of the row

Right Glove

Row 58: k until M2, sIM2, work the chart, sI M3, k8, place next 20 stitches on scrap yarn, place next 20 stitches on scrap yarn, join into the round and k until the end of the row

Hand

Left and right glove

Row 59: k until the end of the row (56 m)

Work row 59 twelve times (until the base of the little finger)

Left Glove

Row 71: k22, place next 12 sts on scrap yarn, CO 2 sts, join into the round and k until the end of the row

Row 72-73-74 : k (46 sts)

Right glove

Row 71: k7, place next 12 sts on scrap yarn, CO 2 sts, k until the end of the row, CO 2 sts and join in round.

Row 72-73-74 : k (46 sts)

Fingers

Separate the work as follows to form the fingers:

Place 14 sts (7 from the front and 7 from the back) on DPN or circ needle to work the forefinger

Place 8 sts from the front and 8 from the back on a scrap yarn (middle finger)

Place 8 sts from the front and 8 from the back on a scrap yarn (ring finger)

Forefinger

Begin of the row: Pick up the stitches on the back of the glove and begin near the middle finger

Row 1: k until the end of the row, CO 2sts and join into the round (16sts)

Row 2-25: k

Row 26-27: * k2tog *, repeat to * from * until the end of the row

Cut the yarn, draw to rem 4 sts, pull up and sew in the inside of the finger.

Thumb

Place the 20 sts placed in a scrap yarn, pick up 4 sts on the hand and join into the round (24 sts).

Row 1 : k

Row 2: k20, ssk, k2tog

Row 3: k20, k2tog

Row 4: k19, k2tog

Row 5-18: k

Row 19-20: ** k2tog *, repeat to * from * until the end of the row

Cut the yarn, draw to rem 5 sts, pull up an sew in the inside of the finger.

Middle finger

Begin of the row: Pick up the sts on the back of the glove and begin near the ring finger

Row 1: k8, pick up 2 sts on the forefinger, k8, CO 2sts and join into the round (20 sts)

Row 2-27: k

Row 28-29: * k2tog *, repeat to * from * until the end of the row

Cut the yarn, draw to rem 5 sts, pull up an sew in the inside of the finger.

Chart

= k

= p

= slk slip one as if to knit

= inc 5 increase 5 stitches in the same stitch

= k5

= k5tog knit 5 stitches tog

= T2B sl1 to cable needle, hold at

front, k1, p1 from the cable needle

= T2F sl1 to cable needle, hold at back, p1, k1 from the cable needle

Ring finger

Begin of the row : Pick up the sts on the back of the glove and begin near the little finger

Row 1: k8, pick up 2 sts on the middle finger, k8 and join into the round (18 sts)

Row 2-25 : k

Row 26: * k2tog *, repeat to * from * until the end of the row

Row 27: * k2tog *, repeat to * from * until the last st, k1

Cut the yarn, draw to rem 5 sts, pull up an sew in the inside of the finger.

Little finger

Begin of the row: Pick up the sts on the front of the glove and begin near the ring finger

Row 1: k12, pick up 2 sts on the ring finger join into the round (14 sts)

Row 2-18: k

Row 19: * k2tog *, repeat to * from * until the end of the row


Row 20: * k2tog *, repeat to * from * until the last st, k1

Cut the yarn, draw to rem 5 sts, pull up an sew in the inside of the finger.

Finishing

Weave loose ends.

Use them to close the little holes between the fingers.



Cabled Chart

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The chart is worked in round. Each row is knitted from right to left.
