# GEMSTONE

Beanie

Gauge: 17 sts /22 rows in stockinette

stitch after blocking

## Yarn suggested:

Drops Nepal color 0501 approx. 90-[105]m (98 y-[115 y]) 2 skeins

### Notions and needles:

A 5 mm (US 8) circ needle A 5.5 mm (US 9) circ needle tapestry needle A stitch marker

*Size*: approx. 55-58 cm (21-23'')

**Note**: To create this pattern, I was inspired by the Cocoon Snood's stitches from Mon Petit Violon. This beanie is knitted in the round.

#### **Abréviations**

k : knit

**p** : purl

k1b: knit one into the back of

the stitch

**sl** : slip

pm: placer marker

**M1R**: make one right (pick up the bar between two sts, bring the needle from the back to the front and knit this st in the front of the st)

Mx: make x sts out of one st

Kntog: knit n sts together

#### Patron

Using 5 mm needles, CO 92 [96] sts using your favourite method

Join in the round and pm.

Row 1: \*k1, k1b, k1, p1\* until the end of the row

Row 2: \*k3, p1\* until the end of the row

Rep rows 1 and 2 3 more times (8 rows)

Rep rows 1 one more time (9 rows)

Row 10 : size 55 : M1R after the 23<sup>th</sup> , 46<sup>th</sup>, 69<sup>th</sup> et 92<sup>th</sup> st (96 sts)

size 58: M1R after the  $12^{th}$ ,  $24^{th}$ ,  $36^{th}$ ,  $48^{th}$ ,  $60^{th}$ ,  $72^{th}$ ,  $84^{th}$  et  $96^{th}$  st (104 sts)

With the 5.5 mm needles, work the body of the beanie

Row 11: p1, k5, p1, k1 until the end of the row

Row 12: p1, k5, p1, k1 until the end of the row

Row 13: p1, k5tog, p1, M5 until the end of the row

Row 14: p1, k1, p1, k5 until the end of the row

Row 15: p1, k1, p1, k5 until the end of the row

Row 16: p1, k1, p1, k5 until the end of the row

Row 17: p1, k1, p1, k5 until the end of the row

Row 18: p1, k1, p1, k5 until the end of the row

Row 19: p1, M5, p1, k5tog until the end of the row

Row 20: p1, k5, p1, k1 until the end of the row

Row 21: p1, k5, p1, k1 until the end of the row

Row 22: p1, k5, p1, k1 until the end of the row

Row 23: p1, k5, p1, k1 until the end of the row

Row 24: p1, k5, p1, k1 until the end of the row

Row 25 : p1, k5tog, p1, M4 until the end of the row (84-[91] sts)

Row 26: p1, k1, p1, k4 until the end of the row

Row 27: p1, k1, p1, k4 until the end of the row

Row 28: p1, k1, p1, k4 until the end of the row

Row 29: p1, k1, p1, k4 until the end of the row

Row 30 : p1, M3, p1, k4tog until the end of the row (72-[78] sts)

Row 31: p1, k3, p1, k1 until the end of the row

Row 32: p1, k3, p1, k1 until the end of the row

Row 33: p1, k3, p1, k1 until the end of the row

Row 34 : p1, k3tog, p1, M2 until the end of the row (60-[65] sts)

Row 35: p1, k1, p1, k2 until the end of the row

Row 36: p1, k1, p1, k2 until the end of the row

Row 37: p1, k1, p1, k2tog until the end of the row

Row 38: p1, k1 until the end of the row



Row 39: remove the marker, sl the next st on the right hand needle, pm, knit the next 2 sts together until the end of the row (24-[26] sts)

Row 40: k until the end of the row

Row 41: k2tog until the end of the row (12-[13] sts)

Row 42: k until the end of the row

### **Finishing**

Cut the yarn, Thread remaining stitches with the yarn. Pull firmly to close the top of the beanie. .Weave in all ends invisibly on WS of fabric. Block lightly with an iron.
